Every year in **Mexico** we have 5,000 new cases of childhood cancer, unfortunately, a huge of this children's doesn't have the opportunity to access to an oncological treatment, because of the lack of social opportunities, social secure and low incomes.

In **Casa de la Amistad para Niños con Cáncer**, we have more than 30 years supporting to low-income children's and youth people from 0 to 21 years old with cancer to access to oncological treatment, medicines and studies and specific support as lodging, nutritional meals, clothing, pantry, emotional and psychological workshops, educational scholarship programs, transfers and transportation, all free of cost.

Our main purpose is to increase the childhood cancer survival rate in Mexico, through 4 lines of action:

TIMELY DECTION

Awareness campaigns for the timely detection of signs and symptoms of childhood cancer.



EARLY ATTENTION

Provide comprehensive and complementary support services, immediately treatments in hospitals from the Health Sector.



ADEQUATE FIDELITY

Support trainings for medical staff: doctors, nurses, social workers, to ensure they have the necessary and updated knowledge in their specialty.



TREATMENT FIDELITY

In order to decrease the level of treatment abandonment, we provide educational, emotional and nutritional support; as well transportation and lodging services.
